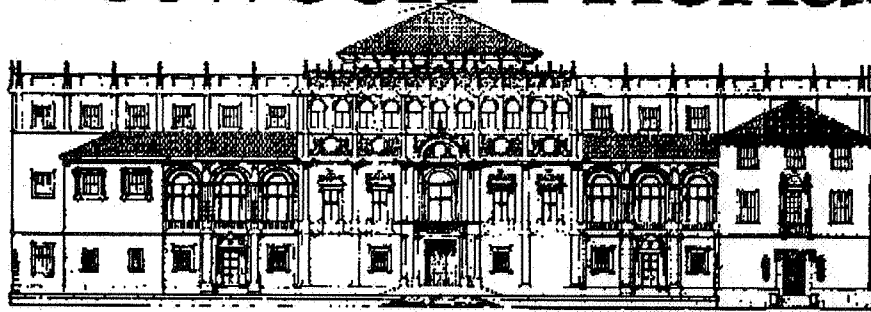

May 31, Annual Meeting Features Harry Middleton, author of *LBJ - The White House Years*

You are invited to attend the Friends Annual meeting on Thursday, May 31, 1990 at 5:30 p.m. in the Julia Ideson Building Auditorium.

Harry J. Middleton, Director of the Lyndon Baines Johnson Library in Austin and author of a new book, *LBJ - The White House Years* will be the keynote speaker.

Middleton was a staff assistant to LBJ in Washington. He wrote speeches for the President and messages to the Congress

delineating need for new legislation.

Middleton also served as special assistant to the former President between January 20, 1969 to May 18, 1970. He worked with President Johnson in the preparation of his memoirs of his presidency, *The Vantage Point* and wrote the draft of *The Choices We Face* by President Johnson.
