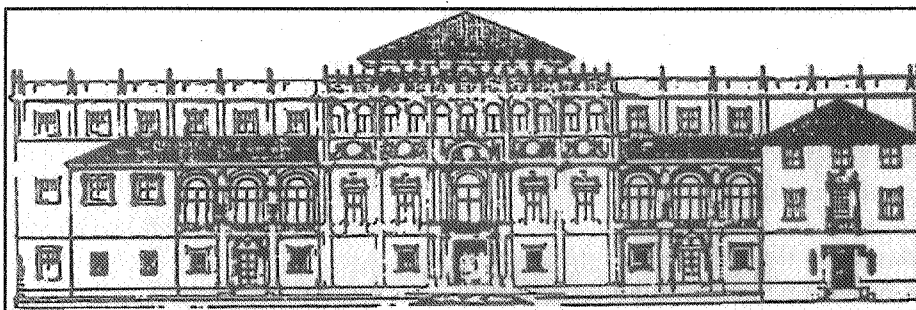

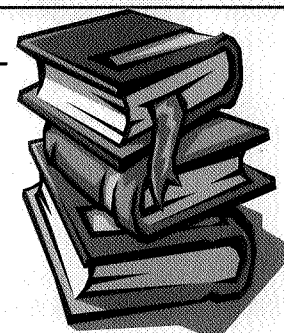
## CHILDREN'S STORYTELLING PARTY COMING SATURDAY DECEMBER 10
