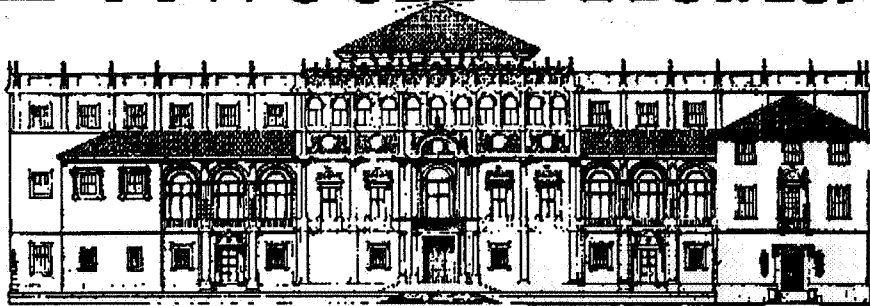

The Friends of the Houston Public Library are pleased to invite their members to the Houston Area Booksellers Association's Annual Book & Author Dinner. The evening promises to be both inspiring and exciting, as some of America's best-known authors share their experiences.

Guest speakers include Erma Bombeck, author and humorist; Robert Fulgham, non-fiction author of *All I Really Need to Know I Learned in Kindergarten* (which made Number One on the N.Y. Times Best Seller List); Roger Zelazny, science fiction author of *Knight of Shadows*, and Arianna Huffington Stassinopoulos, author of *Picasso; Creator & Destroyer*.

Mistress of Ceremonies will be He-loise, the helpful hint columnist.

The dinner will be held on Thursday, October 19, 1989 at the Westin Galleria Hotel. A cocktail reception and author signing begins at 6:30 p.m with a seated dinner following.

Cost is \$25 per person with proceeds donated to Houston Public Library. It is

anticipated that close to \$15,000 will be donated to the Library. The Book and Author Dinner is sponsored by the Houston *Chronicle* along with 45 local bookstores.

Last year over 800 people attended the dinner and 1,000 are expected to enjoy this year's event. *The dinner is usually sold out, so early reservations are highly recommended!* Reservations are taken on a first come, first-serve basis.

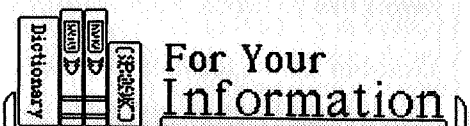
